



- Teachers have control over content in class through an App called Classroom



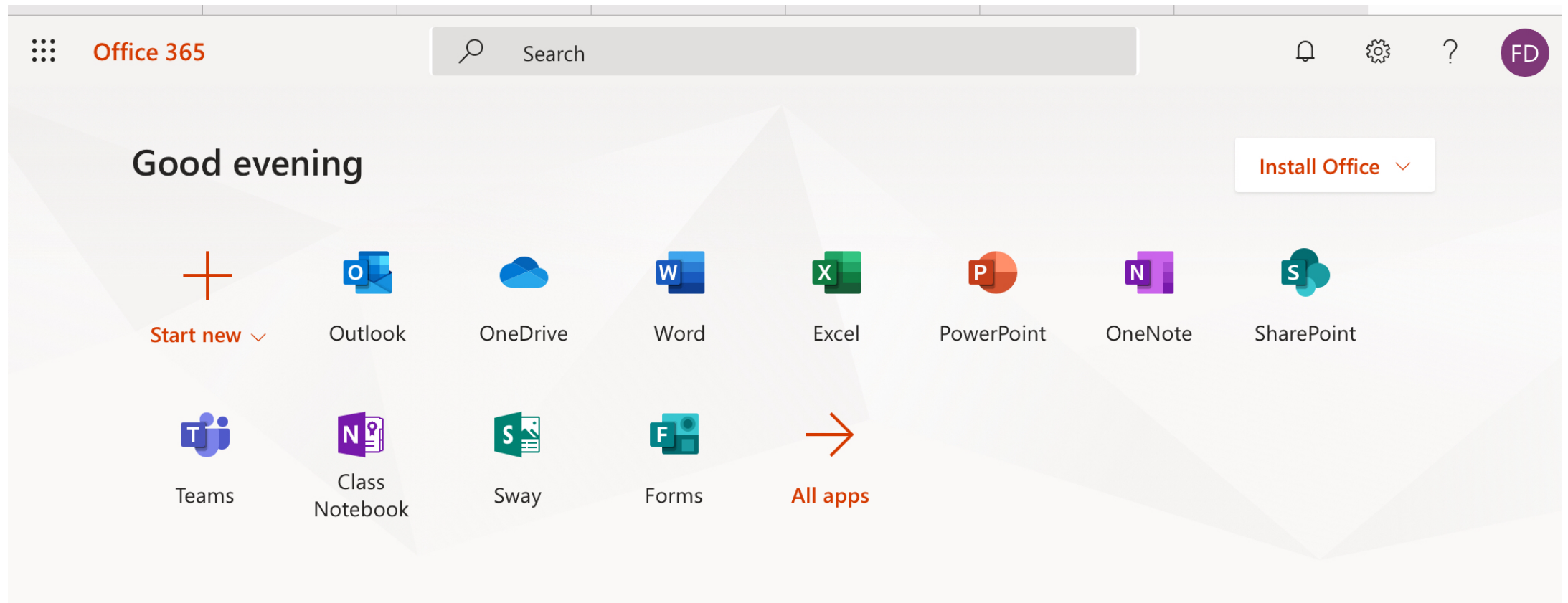

Step 3: get another piece and mark out a large-ish waste piece and also glue the other two pieces together with the pieces matching up with the markings

Step 4: after the two pieces are glued and you have a third one glue that in too and then add in another block at the bottom, this will be your base

Step 5: get another block of wood that's long and plane on the edges then sand so it's rounded, then (optional) you can cut a slant of the piece of wood, I did not do that though and if you want you can then pyrograph a design onto it

Step 6: Then glue the piece you just made onto the base you have made previously

Step 7: add on the wheels, you can't have a train without wheels so you drill them in

Step 8: this is the last step and it's just add ons, I've added on a curved platform at the Tom of my train, a little button at the front and a pipe coming out from the middle

Evaluation

I'm pretty happy with how I did, but I feel like I could've done better with more time, just sanding it down a bit more, measuring it better and adding finishing touches but overall I think I did pretty well, the thing I am most happy with it the design I did at the side of the train of the leaves, I think it looks pretty cool :)

Attendance

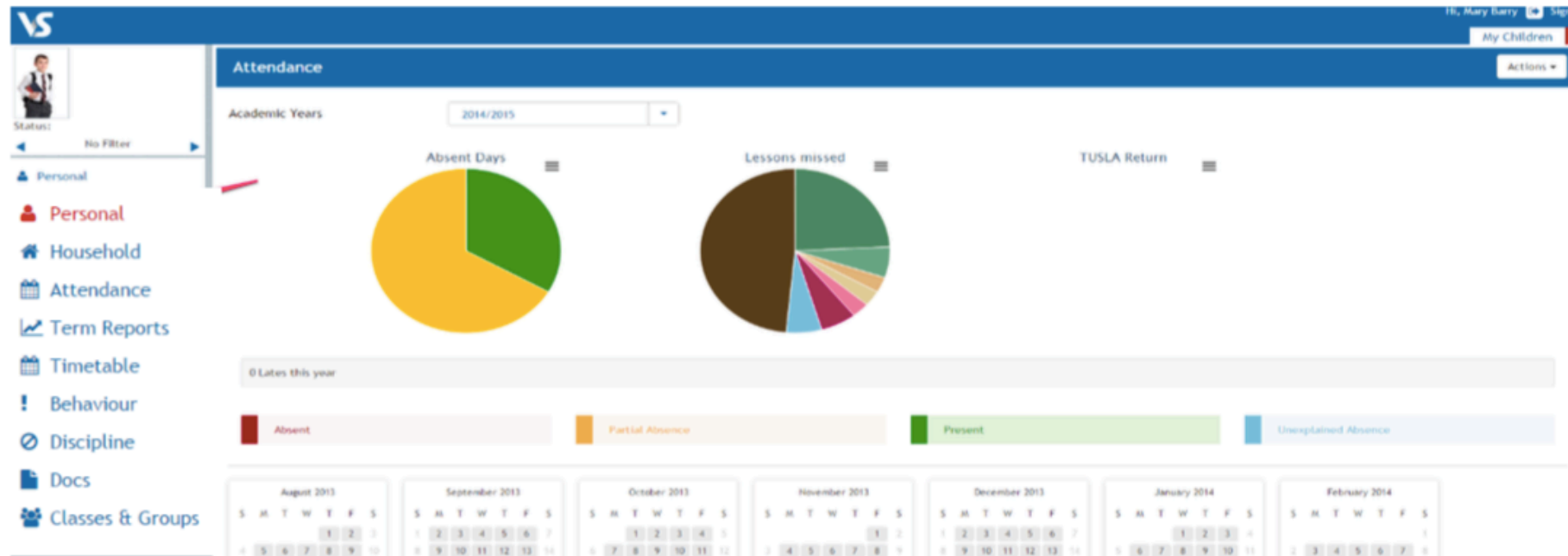
In the “Attendance” section, you can view a breakdown, by class, of attendance.

Days when your child has been absent for the whole day will appear in red.

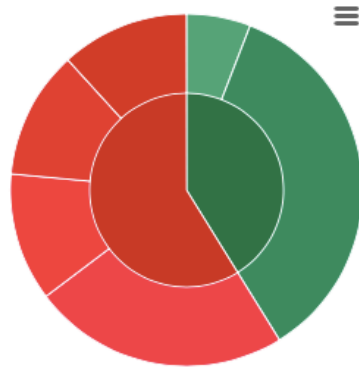
Partial absences will appear as yellow and the date appears green if all classes on that particular day have been attended.

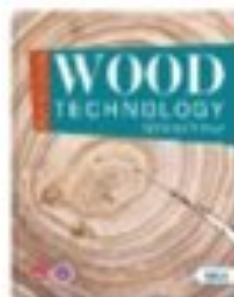
