Dear Sir/Madam,

This is to confirm that Section 7 (Employers Liability) of the above numbered Policy has been extended to indemnify the Host Employer (named below) in respect of their legal liability arising solely out of and in connection with their participation in the student work experience placement arranged by the Insured, and which results in Bodily Injury to the Student named below arising solely out of and in connection with the duties of the Student (detailed below) whilst engaged in the Business of the Host Employer in the Republic of Ireland.

The cover provided under this extension is subject to:

- (a) the Host Employer, as though they were the Insured, observing, fulfilling and being subject to the Terms, Definitions, Conditions, Exclusions, Endorsements and Limits of the Policy insofar as they can apply;
- (b) the Insurer having the full conduct and control of all Claims for which indemnity is provided by this Extension;
- (c) nothing in this Extension serving to increase the liability of the Insurer to pay any amount in excess of the Limit of Indemnity in the Policy and indemnity will apply in priority to the Insured.
- (d) this indemnity shall not apply in respect of any adult education or apprenticeship placements or training.

The indemnity provided by this Extension does not apply in respect of legal liability arising or in connection with the following:

- (a) atomic energy risks
- (b) aviation work or airport risks (but this does not apply to ground operations, catering, hangar observation or offices/reception areas of airports)
- (c) demolition work of any kind
- (d) work in mines, collieries or quarries
- (e) ship breaking or ship repairing
- (f) tunneling or work in sewers
- (g) stevedoring or dockside risks
- (h) any work in connection with explosives
- (i) gas works or filling of any gas into cylinder
- (j) tree felling or lopping
- (k) any work carried out at a height in excess of 5 metres (but this height limit is not necessarily from ground level. It may be from a first floor or some secure level)
- (I) excavations below 3 metres in depth
- (m) work in reservoirs
- (n) driving a mechanically propelled vehicle
- (o) work on a boat or trawler
- (p) use of any oxyacetylene or electric welding or cutting plant or any blow lamp or blow torch unless the student is wearing personal protective equipment and is directly supervised by the Host Employer.
