<b>Graphics</b>	<b>CBA 2: Graphical Presentation</b> Students develop and present a graphical solution to a design brief. <b>Visual Art</b>	<b>CBA 2: Communicate &amp; Reflect</b> Students create a realised work based on their research and ideas.
