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| SPHE (Rang Moy) | My Life Project Students research and reflect on a chosen aspect of their lives demonstrating their ability to investigate and present their findings in a creative and meaningful way. | 1st - 19th September |
| Wood Technology | CBA2: Student Self-Analysis and Evaluation Students evaluate their own project work and reflect on their learning and skill development, demonstrating their ability to critically assess their progress and identify areas for improvement in the design and manufacture process. | 1st - 19th September |
| Applied Technology | CBA2: Innovative Design Challenge Design and manufacture an innovative technological solution to a given problem. Students demonstrate their ability to apply their knowledge and skills in technology to develop and produce a functional prototype. | 8th - 26th September |



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| Graphics | CBA 2: Graphical Presentation Students develop and present a graphical solution to a design brief. This demonstrates their ability to apply their knowledge and skills in graphical communication to create a comprehensive and visually effective presentation. | 15th September - 3rd October |
| Visual Art | CBA 2: Communicate & Reflect Students create a realised work based on their research and ideas. They present this work for discussion and feedback demonstrating their ability to reflect on their artistic process and communicate their creative intentions effectively. | 14th November |
| Home Economics | CBA2: Food Literacy Skills Brief Students research, plan, prepare and evaluated a food related task. They demonstrate their ability to apply their knowledge and skills in food and nutrition to create a well-balanced and appealing dish. | 1st - 19th December |
